Dear Year 5 Parents/Carers

I am delighted to inform you that we will commence swimming on Friday 12th September and thereafter every Friday until the last lesson on Friday 19th December 2024. Lessons will be provided by 'Get in the Swim' and will take place at Meadgate School. Children will walk across to Meadgate School with their class teacher and additional adults.

The cost of the 14 lessons would normally be £63.00 (£4.50 per week) per child, however Larkrise School has decided to continue to heavily subsidize the cost to parents from our school budget.

We are therefore asking for a voluntary contribution of **just £28.00** (£2.00 per week). This should be paid in full in advance by Friday 12th September 2025, through our online payment system Arbor.

May I remind all parents that their child must be equipped every Friday with a one-piece swimsuit for girls, briefs for boys (no bermuda or boxer-shorts please) towel and swimming hat. Please ensure your child has their own swimming hat as we will not be able to lend these out at the moment. Children with verrucas must be provided with a verruca sock. All earrings must be removed for swimming (preferably left at home on the day) and no talcum powder is allowed in the changing rooms.

Swimming is a compulsory part of the curriculum and children are expected to go if they are well enough to attend school. The only exceptions to this are medical conditions such as grommets, broken limb etc. with which they obviously cannot swim. (In the case of ear problems, please contact the class teacher directly)

It is important, however, that in all weather (even fine) your child wears a coat or jacket for walking to and from Meadgate School in case of rain.

For us to be able to group the children please complete the return slip and indicate how far your child can swim unaided.

If you have any questions, please ask your child's class teacher or the office staff.
